I don't know if that meant an attorney that represents the state or an organization that represents RDHAPs. Added that this does not work all the time.

- Under the CA Business & Professions code: "1928. A registered dental hygienist in alternative practice may submit or allow to be submitted any insurance or third-party claims for patient services performed as authorized pursuant to this article. (Added by Stats. 2008, Ch. 31, Sec. 47. Effective January 1, 2009. Operative July 1, 2009, by Sec. 55 of Ch. 31.)"

* Sandra Henriquez stated "I'm generally paid by the Pt, but I fill their insurance forms out for them so they can submit them. However, I've needed to contact their insurance comp to have my business info NPI, tax ID # etc put into their system. Every time I've called they have been more than helpful".
